

As owners of the Ambulance Authority Richmond and Lenox Township residents as well as all those living in the Village of New Haven pay zero out of pocket cost:

Richmond and Lenox Township residents as well as all persons living in the Village of New Haven, receive ambulance service with no out of pocket cost. This means when a resident of these 3 communities calls the EMS for any reason, their insurance company may be billed. However, the cost of any co-payment, deductible or uncovered service is absorbed by the subsidies paid by the Townships of Richmond and Lenox, consequently the resident pays nothing out of pocket for ambulance service.

The Ambulance Authority also contracts to provide EMS for the City of Richmond, Memphis, and Township of Ray. As well as Casco, Columbus, Riley and Wales Township. These communities pay no subsidy to the EMS. Subsequently their resident's insurance is billed and patients must pay any un-paid balance, including required deductibles, co-payments, associated with Ambulance response.
